The show attracts visitors looking for a taste of French culture and lifestyle. The many attractions include food, wine, property, holidays and of course language learning.

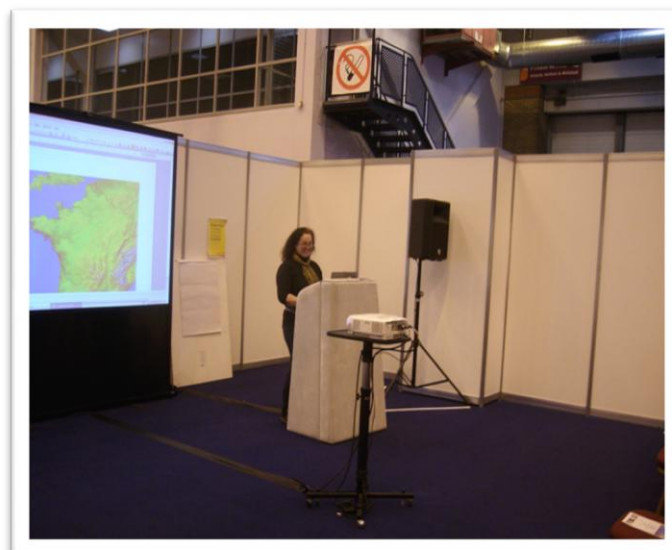
