## The France Show 2010



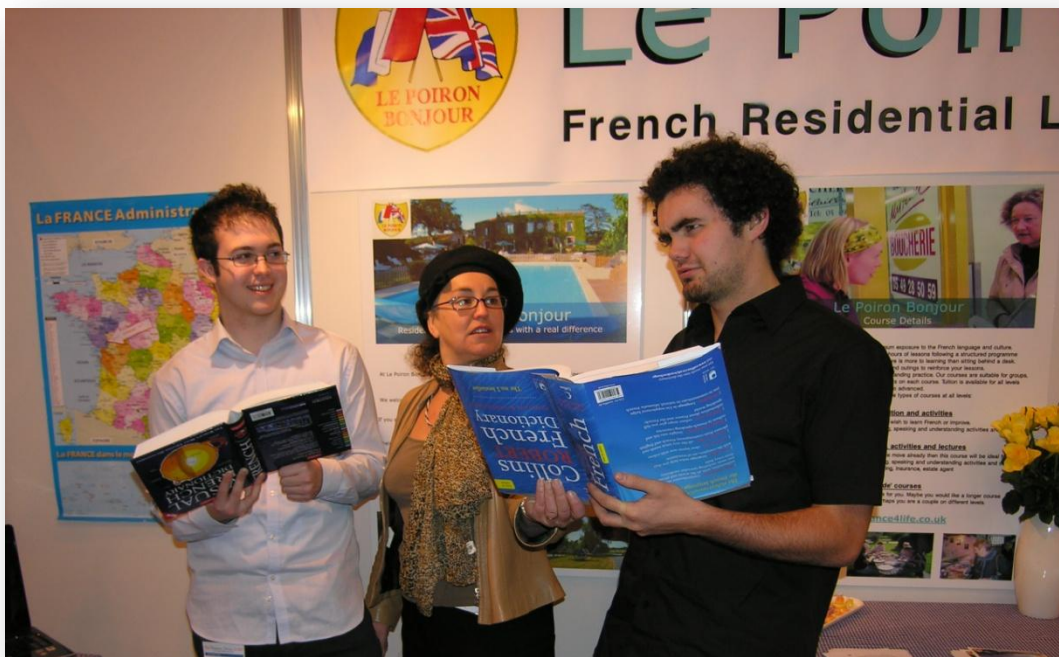
